III. Lakeshore Foundation Junior Board Member Obligations

If selected as a Lakeshore Foundation Junior Board Member, you will be expected to serve a minimum term of two (2) years and a maximum of three (3), after which a minimum one (1) year “roll off” period is required before you may begin another term. Additionally, a Lakeshore Junior Board member is expected to annually fulfill the following requirements:

- Serve as a volunteer for a minimum of 32 hours (up to 12 hours of meeting time can be allocated toward the minimum requirement)
- Attend a majority (i.e., >50%) of Lakeshore Foundation Junior Board meetings.
- Attend a majority (i.e., >50%) of Lakeshore Young Professional meetings.

- Bring a minimum of (5) five people to Lakeshore Foundation events, programs, or to tour the facility.
- Pay membership dues of \$100.
- Directly participate in Lakeshore's Fund Development program. This includes participation in activities such as holiday card sales, recruiting sponsors for annual events and selling tickets to fundraisers. Additionally, each Junior Board member will be responsible for soliciting gifts toward a pre-determined Junior Board goal.

Failure to meet or exceed the member obligations outlined above will result in the member's inability to renew their membership on the Junior Board in the subsequent year. Reasonable extenuating circumstances will be considered by the Executive Committee. Compliance with Junior Board membership obligations is monitored and coordinated by the Vice-President of Membership.
